A common cause of lameness in cutting horses, proximal suspensory ligament pain often results from bone and/or ligament injury at the upper portion of the cannon bone, where the suspensory ligament attaches.

Horses that are driven or ridden in a straight line are less affected by lower limb lameness than those horses who are asked to continually and repeatedly turn circles and make complicated lateral movements.

Repetitive movements of horses performing certain events may cause predictable injuries, such as palmar heel pain and

Abscess is an infection of the sensitive tissue of the foot. Abscesses result in varying degrees of lameness, depending on the severity of the abscess. Symptoms include the hoof being hot and an increased pulse. The abscess will take the path of least resistance and migrate up the hoof and break out at the coronary band.

Western Performance Horse Injuries and Problems - The Horse

Certain breeds and disciplines are more commonly predisposed to developing specific lameness conditions. Examples include arthritis in the knee (carpus) in racehorses, hock arthritis in cutting horses, and hind limb suspensory lameness in dressage horses.

The most common presenting complaint is that horses would not reverse direction to stay on individual cattle during cutting. Lameness was more common in hind limbs (67%) compared with forelimbs (33%) with the stifle being the most common site for lameness affecting 25% of horses.
